Dear Hockey Players,

The Baltimore Blizzard Women's Ice Hockey Club invites you to participate in our newest hockey program. We are offering a Friday night program for women and girls (ages 12 and older) starting January 4, 2002.

The in-house program will take place at the Mimi DiPietro Family Skating Center in Patterson Park in Baltimore. Each team will play nine regular-season games and one playoff game. The in-house league will consist of four evenly matched teams. Sisters and/or mothers and daughters may request to be assigned to the same team. Games will be held every Friday evening from January 4th through March 8th at either 9:15 pm or 10:30 pm.

The cost for the in-house program is \$120. Players not already registered with USA Hockey must pay an additional \$26 for insurance and annual membership. The cost for the in-house program includes a jersey with the Blizzard logo and a number.

Player of all levels are invited to join the program, although some experience is necessary as there will be no coaching or instruction provided.
